

I have an illegal landmark tree removal at 13506 132ND AVE NE. This was discovered through the 1st review of LSM24-03245. The attached survey dated 12/11/23 was submitted with the LSM and shows a 30" pine stump. On google street view, the tree was existing in April of 2023. The removal happened somewhere between then. There are no tree removal approvals on the property. I reached out to the owner who admitted they removed it due to a dangerous lean. They have no arborist documentation of that, however.
